

Purpose Built Schools Atlanta Board of Directors Community Input Policy *Adopted June 2020*

Purpose Built Schools Atlanta welcomes members of the community to attend the meetings of the PBSA Board of Directors, all of which are conducted pursuant to the Georgia Open Meetings Laws. PBSA Board meetings are primarily business meetings at which the business of the schools is conducted. The PBSA Board of Directors shall include a Community Input item on the agenda of all regularly scheduled Board meetings. Any member of the public who wishes to address the Board may do so during the Community Input period by signing up prior to the meeting (by signing the Community Input Log at the entrance of the board room, or other such procedure as clearly noted prior to the start of each meeting). Each person may have up to three minutes to address the Board at that time. The Board will take each comment under advisement and may assign a staff member to follow up on any issue raised, but will not respond directly to individual comments during this period. The Board will not entertain comments on individual students or employees during the Community Input period.

The Board of Directors authorizes the CEO to develop administrative procedures to implement this policy.
